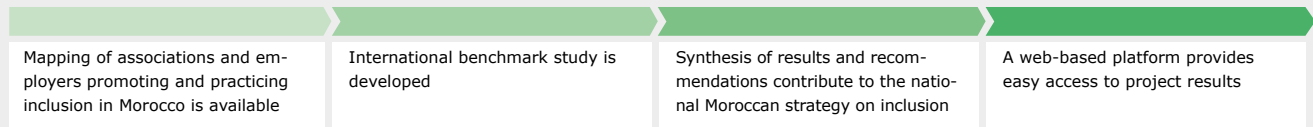

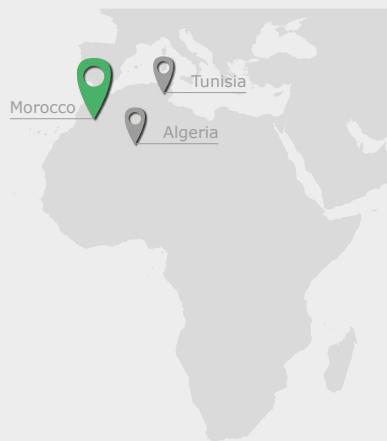

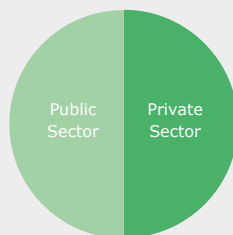

About the Innovation Fund
